SOMMELIER'S PICKS

WHITES

MARTIN RAY "BALD MOUNTAIN", CHARDONNAY SANTA CRUZ MOUNTAINS '14 \$ 72.00

The name Martin Ray resonates deeply in the history of California Winemaking. Martin Ray was a pioneer, dedicated to crafting single varietal, region specific wine from 1943 through 1972 in Saratoga, in the heart of the Santa Cruz Mountains. Mentored by Paul Masson, he took a burgundian approach to his winemaking, and developed what is now one of the most historical properties in California, known as Mount Edn. Nearly twenty years later, Courtney Benham stumbled upon 1500 cases of Martin Ray wine in a San Jose warehouse. Recognizing his good fortune, and his intent and drive to produce terroir driven wines, Ray's historical significance and philosophy resonated with him. Courtney purchased the brand, and since 1990 has been committed to the production of artisanal wines worthy of the Martin Ray name.

This Santa Cruz Mountains Reserve Chardonnay originates in the steep hillside vineyards of Bald Mountain, farmed by the Beauregard family. The cool coastal climate and high elevation consistently define this wine with crisp acidity and an underlying minerality. Tropical Key lime zest, creamy lemon meringue, juicy golden apples, and Asian pears layered on a decadent base of crème brulee and hints of vanilla. It has a clean but broad palate that is honed nicely by its definitive minerality. Smooth and supple on the front and mid-palate, with bright acids along the sides and finish.

MACON FUISSE, JOSEPH BURRIER BURGUNDY '13 \$55

The Burrier family constitute one of the major properties of Southern Burgundy. Its vineyards cover 43 hectares. The vineyards are managed to promote microbial life in the soil and to encourage deep rooting of the vines. In the cellar the wines are allowed time to ferment slowly and to clarify naturally. It is their belief that this method enables the wines to acquire the true expression of their "Terroir". The Mâcon Fuissé evokes the white flowers and fruits. The wine is rich, structured and well balanced in the mouth with citrus finish.

ENROUTE BY FAR NIENTE, CHARDONNAY BRUMAIRE, RUSSIAN RIVER VALLEY '15 \$70

Established in 2007 by the partners of Napa Valley's FarNiente winery, EnRoute is the culmination of a more than 30-year passion for Pinot Noir at first and Chardonnay in 2013. They have made a serious and deep commitment to the region, establishing vineyards and a winery devoted to capturing the magical essence of Pinot Noir & Chardonnay only. EnRoute Chardonnay, Russian River Valley, "Brumaire," which is named for the morning fog that famously envelops the Russian River Valley. This Chardonnay blend is grown from vineyards carefully planted on Goldridge sandy loam, which lends itself to producing vines that facilitate the concentration of flavors we desire. "Brumaire" showcases the region's vibrant, bright citrus and mineral notes, and the textures that are the trademarks of the region's best Chardonnays.

SOMMELIER'S PICKS

REDS

SANTA RITA PEHUEN, CARMENERE APALTA VALLEY, CHILE '11 \$90

The Santa Rita winery was founded in 1880 by Domingo Fernandez in the same area of Alto Jahuel where its main facilities stand today. From the end of the nineteenth century to mid-1970s, the winery developed under the ownership of the Garcia Huidobro family. In 1988, the Claro group took total control of the winery.

Pehuén is a limited production wine crafted from the finest grapes of a single vineyard in the Apalta Valley, an outstanding wine with distinctive quality and unique style that reflects the maximum potential of the Carménère variety. Pehuene is intense and deep carmine red color. Its complex bouquet that elegantly combines the fresh black fruit and the spice notes typical of the variety with the character given by the oak. Concentrated on the palate with a freshness developed from the acidity and the character of the variety. Good structure and depth.

MIURA "WILLIAMS", PINOT NOIR ANDERSON VALLEY '12 \$99

*This vineyard belongs to Burt Williams of Williams & Selyem fame. After Burt and Ed Selyem sold their winery in 1997 Burt decided to buy a hillside parcel and planted it in 1998. There are wonderful clonal selections to work with, including Pommard, Dijon 115 & 777, a Pinot selection from the Rochioli Vineyard and an old DRC suitcase selection. The fruit exhibits great aromas of cherry and wild berries, with full lush tannins that add to the texture. Vibrant acidity completes the picture for Pinot typically grown in this cooler area of the Anderson Valley. The wine here is the most Burgundy-like of all the Pinots made in California, as it is the coolest grape growing region in the state. Lighter, more fragrant and perfumed, with bright red fruit on the palate. The production goes mostly to Williams Selyem Winery (60, %) The stars finally aligned and they were able to get the first sizeable crop from this property in several years, if one can call less than 200 cases sizeable! Drought type conditions meant the berry size was small but created a very concentrated wine. Emmanuel Kemiji's favorite bottling from this visually stunning property since the 2006. **184 cases produced.***

ALMVS, "SPANOS-BERBERIAN VINEYARD" CABERNET SAUVIGNON PRITCHARD HILL - NAPA VALLEY '10 \$99

ALMVS (al'müss) n. Derived from the Latin term signifying soul. Something that sustains, is saintly, tranquil, pure, serene; brings favor, fertility and abundance.

The grapes come from the Spanos-Berberian Vineyard in the Pritchard Hill area of eastern Napa Valley. Three people collaborate on the final blending— Byron Kosuge, the winemaker of Miura, Sylvain Portay, a well-known French chef, and Emmanuel Kemiji, the owner of Miura Vineyards and a Master Sommelier. ALMVS is not an inky, tannic blockbuster; instead, it is perfumed, almost racy style wine. Something you can drink more than a glass of without bludgeoning your palate. The wine is aged 18 months in new French Oak.

*Bryant, Tom Eddy, Continuum-Tim Mondavi and few other are using the same vineyard. **112 cases produced.***

FAR NIENTE CABERNET, OAKVILLE '12 249

Planted on some of the most beautiful, gravelly loam soil in the Napa Valley, the Martin Stelling vineyard uniformly produces wines with supple tannins, bright, forward fruit, and beautiful tannin structure.



NICKEL & NICKEL CABERNET, "C.C. RANCH", RUTHERFORD '12 178

C.C. Ranch sits along the slope of a knoll west of the Silverado Trail. It is planted on well-drained, gravelly loam soil and the climate is ideal for the variety due to warm summer temperatures that mature tannins and ripen fruit.

NICKEL & NICKEL CABERNET, "HAYNE", ST. HELENA '12 178

The Hayne Vineyard is situated in St. Helena at the base of the Mayacamas Mountain, where warm temperatures are ideal for producing sweet, jammy fruit and this vineyard tends to be picked at the beginning of harvest each year.

NICKEL & NICKEL CABERNET, "QUARRY", RUTHERFORD '14 190

Rock Cairn lies near the southern edge of the Oakville appellation, east of Highway 29 and north of the town of Yountville. The dry-farmed site is comprised of deep, gravelly loam with a wadtern exposure.

NICKEL & NICKEL CABERNET, "JOHN SULLENGER", OAKVILLE '14 190

High in the hills of Diamond Mountain, Sori Bricco spans a wide range of hillsides with different sun exposures resulting in separate harvest dates across the ranch. The soil is composed of a sandy, gravelly loam and the vines tend to be very small as they struggle against the slopes.



BELLA UNION, CABERNET BLEND, NAPA VALLEY '14 170

Located in Rutherford along Bella Oaks Lane—hallowed ground for Napa Valley Cabernet—the 25-acre Bella Union Vineyard is planted to Cabernet Sauvignon, with a small portion devoted to Cabernet Franc and Petit Verdot.

CLOS PISSARRA FEATURE

PRIORAT & MONTSANT

The name Clos Pissarra is derived from the Catalan word for slate, as this is the soil that covers the regions of Montsant (sacred mountain) and Priorat (priory), that lie about 85 miles southwest of Barcelona. Priorat has quickly established itself as the premier wine region in Spain producing wines of great intensity and concentration but yet remaining elegant and balanced. Montsant has found a most comfortable niche, being described as a softer and more approachable version of Priorat, at a great value.

CLOS PISSARRA ARISTAN, SYRAH, GARNACHA — MONTSANT '10 65

Aristan is a five acre vineyard that lies next to our winery. This vineyard is owned by Master Sommelier Emmanuel Kemiji (proprietor of Miura Vineyards in California & Managing Director of Clos Pissarra) and named after his two sons, Aristos and Tristan. Made up entirely of 10-year old Grenache (Garnatxa in Catalan) and Syrah vines on soil that is a mixture of clay and slate. The yields are cut back to a miserly one ton to the acre. 399 cases produced.

CLOS PISSARRA EL RAMÓN, GARNACHA, CARIGNAN, CABERNET SAUVIGNON, BELLMUNT DEL PRIORAT— PRIORAT '10 79

El Ramon (meaning the one known as Ramon in Catalan) refers to a 6 acre vineyard in the old mining town of Bellmunt in Priorat, owned by Ramon Marco who is our vineyard manager. This vineyard is planted to Grenache (Garnatxa), Carignan (Samso in Catalan) and Cabernet Sauvignon in even portions. It is a trellised and terraced vineyard, very steep, and the only thing you see on the ground is slate (locally known as licorella) as is typical in the region. Yields are typically less than a ton per acre. 342 cases produced.

CLOS PISSARRA EL MONT, GARNACHA, EL LLOAR — PRIORAT '09 90

El Mont (meaning the mountain in Catalan) refers to a 1.5 hectare vineyard (3.75 acres) in the town of El Lloar in Priorat. The vineyard sits at the base of an incredible and very steep mountain and the whole scene creates a profound impression on any visitor. This vineyard is planted entirely to Grenache (Garnatxa). It is a trellised and terraced vineyard with a very unusual, for the region that is, blend of clay, granite and the more commonly found slate. Yields are less than ¾ of a ton per acre. 109 cases produced.
